The Anaesthesia Assistant is responsible and accountable to the Manager, Interprofessional Practice for the provision of advanced respiratory care as established by the College of Respiratory Therapists of Ontario and the standards of respiratory care of this hospital. As an advanced practitioner the Anesthesia Assistant provides clinical and technical assistance in the care of the stable surgical patient during general, regional or local anesthesia.

The Anaesthesia Assistant provides constant assessment and evaluative monitoring of the depth of anesthesia under the direct supervision of the Anesthesiologist and with the use of medical directives, as applicable. The Anesthesia Assistant is also an integral member of the Allied Health team to which there are accountabilities for professional practice, education and research.

Education:

- Graduation from an accredited Respiratory Therapy program, or recognized equivalent.
- Current license with the College of Respiratory Therapy of Ontario.
- Completion of accredited Anesthesia Assistant Advanced Program.
- Certified in BCLS and ACLS required.

Qualifications/Experience:

- Minimum 5 years' experience in a Critical Care setting.
- Minimum 2 years recent Operating Room experience preferred.
- Minimum 1-2 years' experience in an Anesthesia Assistant role preferred.
- Demonstrated experience and proficiency in the following skills:

- Management of difficult airways, using adjunctive devices and specialty devices
 - Peripheral IV insertion
 - Arterial Line insertion
- Ophthalmology conscious sedation
