Position description

The Department of Anesthesia of McGill University and the McGill University Health Centre (MUHC) invites applications for the position of an experienced anesthesiologist in the Department of Anesthesia. The successful applicant will hold a full-time academic appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor (Clinical), as a member of the Contract Academic Staff. This position does not confer eligibility for tenure.

The ideal candidate must have at least five years of clinical experience as anesthesiologist for adults. The candidate must possess research experience in regional anesthesia with publications in high impact journals, have a strong academic background, and be able to serve as mentor to fellows, residents and colleagues. The candidate must also possess skills and experience in advance techniques in regional anesthesia for severe trauma, complex thoracic and complex oncologic cases.

Appropriate non-clinical time will be allocated according to the needs and agreed mandate.

As a university health centre, it is expected that all attending anesthesiologists have additional fellowship training and expertise. Recognized training and experience in cardiac, thoracic, trauma, or regional anesthesia is an asset.

Qualifications and Education Requirements

Candidates must:

- Hold an MD degree and be eligible for licensure by the College des Médecins du Québec;
- Possess anesthesia specialty certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons (FRCPC), or equivalent;
- Hold a fellowship in regional anesthesia;
- Fulfill the requirements for the Office québécois de la langue française (OQLF).
